PARKING: All busses, team vehicles & spectators should come in on Highway E and then turn left onto HY

JR to access the UW-Parkside Physical Education or Communication Arts parking lots located off of Hwy JR east of the course. **There Is no participant drop off on Highway JR**. No parking allowed in any of the Petrifying Springs parking lots - this includes teams, coaches, and spectators. The Kenosha County Sheriff Dept. has been and may be ticketing anyone violating this policy. Handicap Parking (with Permit) is allowed in the lot immediately north of the course on

HY JR.UW-PARKSIDE: The UW-Parkside PE Building is off limits to your group.

UW-PARKSIDE: The UW-Parkside Sports & Activities Center is off limits to our group.

WIAA tournament rules prohibits dogs & drones at the meet site. No athletic balls or frisbees are allowed on the site as well. There will be a concession stand run by the UWP

cross country team on the course throughout the day.

ADMISSION: Site Admission: \$6 for adults and the fee for those aged 17 & under & seniors is \$4.

PACKET PICKUP: Packet pickup is located in the tent outside of the finish line building reception room starting at

8:00am

COURSE: The JR 5k course is the newer of the UW-Parkside 5000 meter courses.

All high school meets, including conference were scheduled to run on the course this season.

Restricted areas will be roped off, coned or marked with signage.

Please remember that is prohibited to mark the course in any manner, including paint, streamers, signage, etc. A digital display clock will provide the countdown for each race, and one will provide splits at the 1, 2 & 3 mile marks. No wireless communication devices are allowed. **Once a race** has started, warm-ups on the course are limited to following the race in progress. Girls

may not warmup randomly on the course during the Boys race.

SITE PROCEDURES: Teams must set-upcamp in the designated area "Athletes Only" behind the finish line. This area is

restricted to competing athletes, coaches and officials. No parents, non-participants and other spectators will be allowed in this area. Make sure your parents/fans have been made aware of this policy. Tents and ground tarps are allowed. All warmups and cooldown running must be done

on the Parkside course.

Teams MAY NOT put up tents in Petrifying Springs Park.
