**ENTRY**: **WE WILL RUN A MAXIMUM OF 7 RUNNERS IN THE VARSITY RACES**. Each school may run an unlimited number on the JV level, but only the first 7 finishers will count for team score, per National Federation rules. We will displace runners from incomplete teams in determining team scores in all races.

<u>TIMING & SCORING</u>: The Wisconsin Runner will provide for the timing and scoring/results for this meet utilizing **Race Result** disposable chips in conjunction with **Finish Lynx Ether Lynx Photo Finish** and **Identi Lynx Video** Cameras.

## PARKING:

**UW-P Parking Lots** --- All teams & spectators should come in on Highway E and then turn onto Highway JR to access the UW-Parkside parking lots east of the course. There is no participant drop off on Highway JR.

**No parking allowed in any of the Petrifying Springs Park parking lots** – this includes teams, coaches and spectators. The Kenosha County Sheriff Department has been and will be ticketing anyone violating this policy! Please inform your fans of this information as well.

Handicap Parking (with Permit) is allowed in the Parking Lot immediately North of the course on Highway JR.

## SPECIAL NOTES:

- 1) There will be meet t-shirts on sale at the course.
- 2) There will be a concession stand run by the UW-Parkside Cross Country/Track & Field teams on the course throughout the day.
- 3) The WIAA is stating that there should be NO DOGS at CC Meets this is also the policy of UW-Parkside. Please inform your fans of this policy again this year.
- 4) NO DRONES allowed at UW-Parkside before, during or after the Angel Invitational event.
- 5) No teams are allowed to set up camps in Petrifying Springs Park across the road from the course administration building. You MUST headquarter on the UW-Parkside course set up on either side of the finish line chutes these areas have been widened to accommodate everyone. Please set-up in the designated "Athletes Only" area behind the finish line. No parents and spectators are allowed in this area inform your fans.
- 6) UW-Parkside is charging an admission fee to get onto the course for the duration of the meet, as follows: \$6 for adults; \$3 for seniors and those 17 years of age and younger. PLEASE ALERT YOUR FANS!
- 7) Prepare your runners for what to expect with the UW-Parkside finish chute area with the Race Result. **Tell your runners to continue running until after they enter the chutes it doesn't matter which chute, just keep moving.** This allows their chips to be accurately read on both mats. It also allows all runners the opportunity to have a fair finish, and minimizes the possibility of a runner being injured by impact between runners after the finish line is crossed. There will be a table with water just past the chutes.
- 8) Meet entries from all schools will be posted after the entry deadline on the WI Runner website listed earlier.
