**COURSE:** The course being run is the original UW-Parkside 5K course. Runners will run through the woods from 1 ½ to 1 ½ miles (not down the main straightaway). This is the course on which all high school meets will be conducted this fall. A digital display clock will be used as a countdown for each race and one will be provided for splits at the 1 mile, 2 mile, and 3 mile mark. There will be timing mats at 1 mile and 2 mile as well and LIVE RESULTS will be available at: https://wisconsinrunner.com/results/2025/Case\_Eagle\_Invite/

ONCE THE GIRLS RACE HAS BEGUN, warmups on the course are limited to following the race in progress. Team may not warmup "randomly" on the course while the girls race is in progress.

**TEAM ENTRIES**: Teams will enter the meet on athletic.net. You will be sent an entry invitation by athletic.net which will also include entry instructions. ENTRIES ARE DUE by 8:00 PM SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 28. If you have any problems please contact the WISCONSIN RUNNER (262-633-0033). Teams that do not submit their rosters by the entry deadline will be assessed a \$25.00 late fee which must be paid Race Day. Additions/scratches/race changes/corrections to your entries can be made race day at check-in.

**MEET CHECK-IN ON ARRIVAL**: Eagle Invite coaches check in at the finish line building/tent. **AWARDS**:

- \*\* Team Trophy to the Meet Champion
- \*\* EAGLE INVITATIONAL MEDALS to the Top 15 Finishers.
- \*\* JV MEDALS to the Top 5 Finishers.
- \*\*\*\* There will be a Formal Award Ceremonies: Girls @ 10:45 and Boys @ 12:15.

**TEAM CAMPS -SITE PROCEDURES**: Teams (participants, alternates, coaches, trainers and managers) must enter the meet site together. When an athlete leaves the facility, they will not be allowed to re-enter the site. **TENTS & GROUND TARPS** are allowed. No Team Camps are allowed in Petrifying Springs Park!

**PARKING**: UW-P Parking Lots --- All buses, team vehicles, & spectators should come in on Highway E and then turn onto Highway JR to access the UW- Parkside parking lots east of the course. There is no participant drop off on Highway JR. There is no fee for parking.

Handicap Parking (with Permit) is allowed in the lot immediately north of the course on HWY JR No parking allowed in any of the Petrifying Springs parking lots - this includes teams, coaches and spectators...

\*\* CONCESSIONS: The UW-Parkside XC/T&F team will be operating a concession stand on the course meet day.

- \*\* EVENT T-SHIRTS will be available (more information will be available in September)
- \*\* NO DOGS and NO DRONES are allowed at UW-Parkside before, during or after the Meet.
- \*\* ADMISSION: The admission fee per spectator is \$3.00 for 17 & Under and Seniors and \$6.00 for Adults (18 & over). When a spectator leaves the facility, they will not be allowed to re-enter the site
