ADMISSION FEE: \$6 for adults & seniors. \$3 for those 17 years of age and younger.

<u>TIMING & SCORING</u>: The Wisconsin Runner will provide for the timing and scoring/results for this meet utilizing **Race**Result disposable chips in conjunction with **Finish Lynx Ether Lynx Photo Finish** and **Identi Lynx Video** Cameras. A digital display clock will provide the countdown for each race and one will provide the running time at the 1, 2 & 3 mile marks. There will be unofficial live splits posted for the 1 mile, 2 mile and finish at:

Official results with splits will be posted after the completion and verification of placing of each race to the same site.

<u>COURSE</u>: The course being run is the original UW-Parkside 5K course. Runners will run through the woods from 1 ½ to 1 ½ miles (not down the main straightaway). This is the course on which all high school meets will be conducted this fall. A digital display clock will be used as a countdown for each race and one will be provided for splits at the 1 mile, 2 mile, and 3 mile mark. Once results are verified at the completion of each race official results, including splits, will be posted.

**WARMUPS:** ONCE THE JV BOYS RACE HAS BEGUN, warmups on the course are limited to following the race in progress. Team may not warmup "randomly" on the course while races are in progress.

<u>AWARDS</u>: Trophies to the championship teams on Varsity level, along with team medals to the team champion & team runners-up; trophies to top 10 finishers in Varsity races; medals to finishers 11 – 15 in Varsity races. JV individual winner receives a medal.

## **PARKING:**

**UW-P Parking Lots** --- All teams & spectators should come in on Highway E and then turn onto Highway JR to access the UW-Parkside parking lots east of the course. There is no participant dropping off on Highway JR.

**No parking allowed in any of the Petrifying Springs Park parking lots** – this includes teams, coaches and spectators – PLEASE ALERT YOUR FANS OF THIS POLICY. The Kenosha County Sheriff Department has been and will be ticketing anyone violating this policy! Please inform your fans of this information as well.

**Handicap Parking** (with Permit) is allowed in the Parking Lot immediately North of the course on Highway JR. There will be meet t-shirts on sale at the course.

There will be a concession stand run by the UW-Parkside Cross Country/Track & Field teams on the course throughout the day.

The WIAA is stating that there should be NO DOGS at CC Meets – this is also the policy of UW-Parkside. Please inform your fans of this policy again this year.

NO DRONES allowed at UW-Parkside before, during or after the Angel Invitational event.

No teams are allowed to set up camps in Petrifying Springs Park across the road from the course administration building. You MUST headquarter on the UW-Parkside course – set up behind the finish line in the designated "Athletes Only". No parents and spectators are allowed in this area.
