HIGH SCHOOL ENTRY: Each school may run an unlimited number in the boys and girls high school races. Overall team scores will be kept.

OPEN RACE: This race is open to anyone except high school runners (grade school, junior high, parente, siblings, alumni, running geeks, etc). There is no entry fee and no official times will be kept. There will be a running clock at the finish line. All participants (or their parents if under the age of 18) must sign a event waiver. TIMING & SCORING: The Wisconsin Runner will provide for the timing and scoring/results for this meet utilizing **Race Result** disposable chips in conjunction with **Finish Lynx Ether Lynx Photo Finish** and **Identi Lynx Video** Cameras. Results will be available before the meet ends at https://wisconsinrunner.com/results/2025/Tremper_Invite/
Registration will be done on athletic.net. You will receive an email from them with further registration info. Registration opens at noon August 18th and closes at 6:00pm on Monday, August 25th. Coaches my add runners on race day (There is no fee to add these entrants.) Teams will be charged a late fee of \$25 if they do not register their teams by the entry deadline.

COURSE: The course being run is the original UW-Parkside 5K course. Runners will run through the woods from 1 ¼ to 1 ½ miles (not down the main straightaway). This is the course on which all high school meets will be conducted this fall.

TEAMS: Burlington Area School District, Kenosha Tremper, Kenosha Bradford, Kenosha Christian Life, Kenosha Saint Joseph Academy, South Milwaukee, Waterford Union, Wilmot Union.

AWARDS: Medals to top 5 in each class (freshman, sophomore, junior, senior) in the boys and girls races. Trophies to the overall male and female winners.

PARKING:

UW-P Parking Lots --- All teams & spectators should come in on HWY JR (from the west) or HWY E (from the east) to access the UW-Parkside parking lots east of the course. **There is no participant drop off on Highway JR.**

HWY E will be closed meet day be between HWY JR and HWY 31. (SEE MAP ON MEET HOMEPAGE)

No parking allowed in any of the Petrifying Springs Park parking lots – this includes teams, coaches and spectators.

The Kenosha County Sheriff Department has been and will be ticketing anyone violating this policy!

Handicap Parking (with Permit) is allowed in the Parking Lot immediately North of the course on Highway JR.

There will be a concession stand run by the UW-Parkside Cross Country/Track & Field teams on the course throughout the meet.

The WIAA is stating that there should be NO DOGS at CC Meets – this is also the policy of UW-Parkside.

NO DRONES allowed at UW-Parkside before, during or after the Invitational event.

No teams are allowed to set up camps in Petrifying Springs Park across the road from the course administration building. Please set-up your team camps in the designated "Athletes Only" area behind the finish line. No parents and spectators are allowed in this area – inform your fans.

UW-Parkside is charging an admission fee to get onto the course for the duration of the meet, as follows:

\$6 for adults; \$3 for seniors and those 17 years of age and younger.

Meet entries from all schools will be posted after the entry deadline on the WI Runner website listed earlier.
